not overload the engine. 9. Stop the hedge trimmer if someone approaches you.

Beware of debris that may be thrown out by the trimming blade.

Do not try to cut thick twigs. This hedge trimmer is for trimming foliage.

- 10. Stop the engine and make sure the trimming blade has stopped before making adjustments.
