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

For guidance on managing

- Wear your protective equipment including ear defenders and strong footwear. 1.
- If your mower has a grassbox, do not run it without the grassbox correctly fitted. Stop the 2. engine before you empty the grassbox
- 2 Always hold the mower handle firmly with both hands while working.
- 4.
- Do not let the blades rotate when moving over paving or hard ground, or when first 5.
- positioning the mower to start work. Do not tilt the mower to expose the blades when they are still rotating. You might
- 6. accidentally put your foot into the danger area. The blades may also throw out stones and other debris.
- 7. While working, keep a lookout for any stones or other objects in your path. Stop the engine and clear them out of the way.
- Stop work and stop the engine if someone approaches you. 8.
- If the mower starts to labour and slow down, raise the cutting height so you are removing
